MEMBERSHIP DONATION

Your membership donation helps the PTA provide enrichment and resources of support to the school for all of the students in ways of field enrichment trips, special presentations in school, class community supplies and more.

Membership donations are collected monthly or annually. In 2013, during the election of the founding PS 59 PTA Executive Board, the suggested membership donation amount voted upon would be <u>\$10 each</u> <u>month OR \$100 for the year</u>. Our membership last year has recently added: <u>for each additional child, \$5</u> <u>each month or \$50 for year</u>. *Although this is not mandated*, we ask that all parents donate what they can. All amounts are welcomed and greatly appreciated.

Payments: You can "backpack" the dues back to school, hand them in during the PTA meetings, or drop them off at the main school office in a sealed envelope (Dues envelopes are available in the main office). Please note that a receipt will be provided reflecting all payments received for use as a tax write off.
